NOTICE OF SELECTION OF SUCCESSFUL BIDDER

Seacoast Capital Partners II, L.P. ("Seacoast") files this Notice of Selection of Successful Bidder, and respectfully states as follows:

1. This case was commenced by the filing of an Involuntary Petition (Doc # 1) under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code on March 20, 2009.
2. On October 12, 2010, the Court lifted the automatic stay at Seacoast's request, subject to certain conditions. See "Order Granting Limited Modification of the Automatic Stay on Motion Filed By Seacoast Capital Partners, II, L.P." (the "Lift Stay Order") (Doc # 426)
3. On November 19, 2010, as required by the Lift Stay Order, Seacoast filed its Second Amended Notice of Proposed Bid Procedures (the "Bid Procedures").
4. On November 19, 2010, the Court issued its Order approving the Bid Procedures.
5. On December 22, 2010, Seacoast filed its Notice of Qualified Bids Received by Seacoast (Document #466).
6. Seacoast conducted a public auction of the Auctioned Assets at 10:00 a.m. on December 28, 2010 at the offices of FLEESON, GOOING, COULSON & KITCH, L.L.C.
7. As required by Section V of the Bid Procedures, Seacoast hereby provides notice of the results of the public auction. Seacoast, which had made a "stalking horse" bid in the

amount of \$1,300,000, was selected as the Successful Bidder, in accordance with and subject to the terms of the Bid Procedures and Lift Stay Order.
