

This matter came to be heard upon the Trustee's Motion to Approve Sale of Certain Intangible Assets of Debtor Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §363 Free and Clear of Liens, Claims and Encumbrances (the "Intangibles Motion"). A Limited Objection was filed by Ervin Leasing Company on October 7, 2010. The Court conducted a hearing on October 19, 2010, heard statements by counsel and reviewed all the papers filed. Good cause appearing,

THE COURT FINDS that:

1. On June 4, 2010, Debtor filed for relief under Chapter 7 of the Bankruptcy Code.
2. Debtor's estate includes certain intangible assets including Debtor's website, domain names, URLs, dbas, trade names, trademarks, related logos and artwork, licenses, and phone number (the "Intangibles").

1 3. The Trustee received an offer from Consign & Buy, LLC to purchase the
2 Intangibles for \$2,000. This is the highest and best offer received by the Trustee.

3 4. Regarding the limited objection of Ervin Leasing Company, the Trustee's
4 counsel confirmed at the hearing that the Trustee is not selling any equipment that might be
5 subject to Ervin Leasing's claims.
6

7 5. The sale of the Intangibles is in the best interest of the Estate and its creditors.
8 All parties have acted in good faith in conjunction with the sale.

9 6. The Court requested higher and better bids and received none.
10

11 7. The Property is sold on an "as is, where is" basis with no representations or
12 warranties by the Trustee.

13 Based on the findings above and the events at the sale hearing, and good cause
14 appearing,
15

16 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

17 1. Overruling the Limited Objection of Ervin Leasing Company.
18 2. Approving the Trustee's authority to sell the Intangibles, and approving the sale
19 of the Intangibles to Consign & Buy, LLC for \$2,000. The buyer shall have until close of
20 business, Thursday, October 21, 2010 to make payment in full to the Trustee.

21 3. The sale is "as is, where is" with no representations or warranties by the Trustee
22 made on behalf of the Estate.

24 4. Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 363(m), the reversal or modification of this order on
25 appeal does not affect the validity of the sale unless this Court first authorizes a stay pending
26 appeal.
