TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

This Trademark Assignment (“Assignment”) is made and entered into, *nunc pro tunc*, as of July 25, 2015 (“Effective Date”), by and between MICHAEL SEHL, an individual with an address of 2580 Hadley Valley Road NE, Rochester, MN 55906 (“Assignor”) and the sole shareholder of Assignee, and SEHL PRODUCTIONS, INC. d/b/a BRITE CONCEPTS, a Minnesota corporation with an address of 2580 Hadley Valley Road NE, Rochester, MN 55906 (“Assignee”). Each of the Assignor and Assignee are herein referred to individually as a “Party” and together as the “Parties.”

BACKGROUND

A. Assignor was the owner of all right, title and interest in and to the trademarks set forth in Schedule 1 attached hereto and made a part hereof, together with all registrations and applications for registration thereof, all common law rights with respect thereto (collectively, the “Assigned Trademarks”)

B. Assignor, as of the Effective Date, sold, assigned and transferred to Assignee, Assignor’s entire right, title and interest in and to the Assigned Trademarks; and

C. Assignee and Assignor desire to confirm and record the assignment set forth in this Assignment with the United States Patent and Trademark Office and any other public records for which recording is deemed appropriate by Assignee.

TERMS

1. Assignment. For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Assignor hereby confirms that as of the Effective Date he unconditionally and irrevocably assigned, transferred and conveyed to Assignee, its successors and assigns, all of his right, title, and interest, throughout the world, in, to, and under the Assigned Trademarks and all registrations and applications for registration thereof and all common law rights with respect thereto together with all goodwill of the business in which the mark is used and which is symbolized by the Assigned Trademarks, including, but not limited to, all benefits, privileges, causes of action, and remedies relating to such Assigned Trademarks, including, without limitation, the exclusive rights to (a) apply for and maintain all registrations, renewals and/or extensions thereof, (b) all rights and causes of action to recover past, present and future damages, royalties, fees, profits and other relief including, but not limited to, equitable and injunctive relief ensuing from past, present and future infringement of the Assigned Trademarks, (c) grant licenses or other interests therein and (d) otherwise fully and entirely stand in the place of Assignor in all matters related thereto.

2. Further Assurances. Assignor shall execute any instruments or documents and perform all other acts necessary or appropriate, in the reasonable discretion of the Assignee, to further evidence the intent and purpose of this Assignment.

3. Counterparts. This Assignment may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original but all of which together will constitute one and the same instrument. Delivery of an executed counterpart of a signature page to this Assignment by facsimile, portable document format or other electronic means shall be effective as delivery of a manually executed counterpart to this Assignment.
