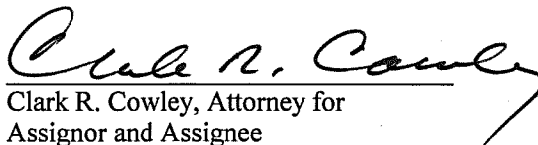

THIS PLAN OF CONVERSION (the "Plan") is entered into as of September 2, 2015 (the "Effective Date") by Rx.com Partners, LLC, a Texas limited liability company, which is converting to Rx.com, Inc., a Texas for-profit corporation.

1. Rx.com Partners, LLC hereby adopts this Plan of Conversion, in order to convert to Rx.com, Inc., a Texas for-profit corporation.

2. By the conversion, Rx.com Partners, LLC will continue its existence in the form of a Texas for-profit corporation.

**CERTIFICATE OF FORMATION OF
RX.COM, INC.
A FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION**

This certificate of formation is submitted for filing pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Texas Business Organizations Code.

Article I - Entity Name and Type

The name and type of filing entity being formed are: Rx.com, Inc., a Texas for-profit corporation (hereinafter the "Corporation").

Article II - Purpose

The purpose for which the Corporation is organized is for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Texas Business Organizations Code.

Article III - Registered Office and Registered Agent

The initial registered agent is an individual resident of the state whose name is Mack Ed Swindle. The business address of the initial registered agent and the initial registered office is: 301 Commerce Street, Suite 3500, Fort Worth, Texas 76102.

Article IV - Conversion

The Corporation is being formed pursuant to a plan of conversion. The name of the converting entity is Rx.com Partners, LLC (the "Converting Entity"). The Converting Entity is a Texas limited liability company organized pursuant to the TBOC. The Converting Entity's date of formation was August 20, 2015. The filing number of the Converting Entity is 802277306. The address of the principal place of business of the Converting Entity is 101 Jim Wright Freeway, Suite 201, Fort Worth, Texas 76108.

Article VII - Effective Date of Filing

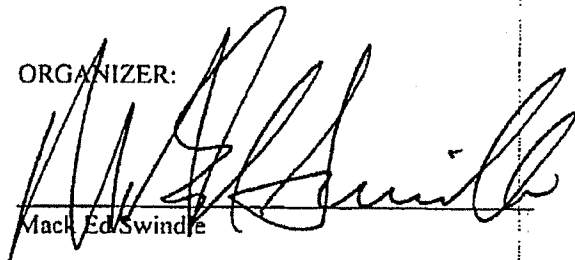
