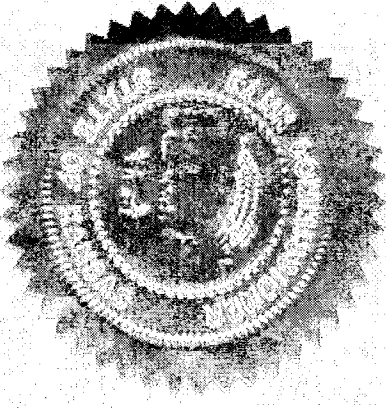

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

NBKC BANK

The undersigned incorporators, for the purpose of forming a banking corporation under the laws of the State of Kansas, make the following Articles of incorporation.

FIRST. The name of the corporation is: NBKC Bank.

SECOND. The address of the corporation's registered office in Kansas is 10700 Nall Avenue, Overland Park, Kansas 66211, and the name of its registered agent at such address is NBKC Bank.

THIRD. The nature of the business or purposes to be conducted or promoted by the corporation is:

(a) To engage in the business of banking and to do all things, exercise all powers and perform all functions which are now or may hereafter be permitted under the Kansas Banking Code; as the same now exists or as the same may be from time to time amended.

(b) To engage in any lawful conduct or activity for which corporations may be organized under The Kansas General Corporation Code; provided, however, that this corporation shall not engage in any activity prohibited by the Kansas Banking Code as the same now exists or as the same may be from time to time amended.

FOURTH. The total number of shares of stock which the corporation shall have authority to issue is One Hundred Thousand (100,000) shares of common stock of the par value of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per share.

FIFTH. The name and address of the sole stockholder of the corporation is Ameri-National Corporation, 10700 Nall Avenue, Overland Park, Kansas 66211. All of the shares of common stock issued and outstanding, including the surplus and undivided profits as required by law, have been fully subscribed and purchased prior to the filing of these Articles.

SEVENTH. The number of directors of the corporation shall be fixed by, or in the manner provided in, the Bylaws, but in no event shall the Board of Directors consist of less than five (5) or more than twenty-five (25) members, a majority of whom shall be residents of Kansas. Directors of the corporation need not be a stockholder in the Corporation or the Corporation's parent, Ameri-National Corporation. The names and mailing addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial directors of the corporation until the first annual meeting of the stockholder or until their successors are elected and qualify are as follows:

Elections of directors need not be by written ballot unless the Bylaws of the corporation so provide.

EIGHTH. The original Bylaws of the corporation shall be adopted by the Board of Directors. Thereafter, the Bylaws of the corporation may from time to time be amended or repealed, or new Bylaws may be adopted, in any of the following ways: (i) by the holders of a majority of the outstanding shares of stock of the corporation entitled to vote thereon, or (ii) by the Board of Directors, and any change so made by the stockholder may thereafter be further changed by the Board of Directors; provided, however, that the power of the Board of Directors to amend or repeal the Bylaws, or to adopt new Bylaws, (A) may be denied as to any Bylaws or portion thereof by the stockholder if at the time of enactment the stockholder shall so expressly provide, and (B) shall not divest the stockholder of its power, nor limit its power, to amend or repeal the Bylaws, or to adopt new Bylaws.

NINTH. Any person, upon becoming the owner or holder of any shares of stock or other securities issued by the corporation, does thereby consent and agree that all rights, powers, privileges, obligations or restrictions pertaining to such person or such

shares of stock or other securities in any way may be altered, amended, restricted, enlarged or repealed by laws of the State of Kansas or of the United States of America hereinafter adopted. The corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal these Articles of Incorporation or to take any other action as required or allowed by such laws, and all rights of the owners and holders of any shares of stock or other securities issued by the corporation are subject to this reservation.

TENTH. The corporation may agree to the terms and conditions upon which any director, officer, employee or agent accepts his office or position and in its Bylaws, by contract or in any other manner may agree to indemnify and protect any director, officer, employee or agent of the corporation, or any person who serves at the request of the corporation as a director, officer, employee or agent of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, employee benefit plan or other enterprise, to the fullest extent permitted by the laws of the State of Kansas.

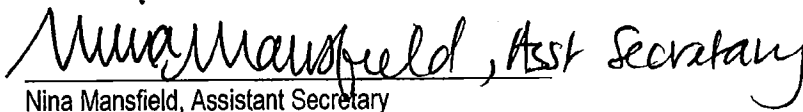
RESOLVED, the Board of Directors do hereby approve the name change to NBKC Bank effective December 18, 2015.
