4. ASSIGNOR hereby warrants and represents that it has not entered into any assignments, contracts or other understandings with third parties which would conflict with the rights herein granted.
5. Except as expressly provided herein, ASSIGNOR makes no representations, warranties, covenants, agreements or indemnities, and hereby disclaims all implied warranties, with respect to the validity of, or ASSIGNOR's or ASSIGNEE's ability to use, register or enforce the Marks.

6. The terms, covenants and provisions of this Assignment shall inure to the benefit of ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns, and/or legal representatives, and shall be binding upon ASSIGNOR, its successors, assigns and/or other legal representatives.

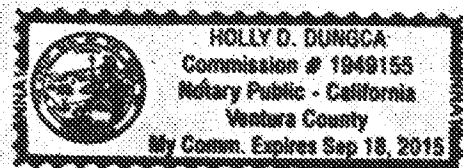

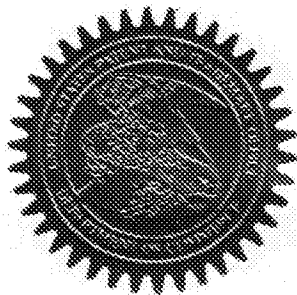
