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## SECOND LIEN TRADEMARK SECURITY AGREEMENT

THIS SECOND LIEN TRADEMARK SECURITY AGREEMENT, dated as of November 5, 2019 (this “Agreement”), between NUMET MACHINING TECHNIQUES, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (together with its successors and assigns, the “Grantor”), and STELLUS CAPITAL INVESTMENT CORPORATION, as Second Lien Administrative Agent (together with its successors and assigns in such capacity, the “Second Lien Administrative Agent”), for the benefit of the Secured Parties (as defined in the Credit Agreement referred to below):

### RECITALS:

(1) This Agreement is made pursuant to (a) the Second Lien Credit Agreement, dated as of the date hereof (as amended, restated or otherwise modified from time to time, the “Credit Agreement”), Bromford Industries Limited, a private limited company organized under the laws of England and Wales with registered number 00474681 (the “UK Borrower”), Bromford Intermediate Holdings, Ltd., an exempted company incorporated with limited liability under the laws of the Cayman Islands (the “Parent”), Bromford Midco Limited, a private limited company organized under the laws of England and Wales with registered number 11262280 (the “UK Parent”), Bromford Group Limited, a private limited company organized under the laws of England and Wales with registered number 06867493 (“UK Holdings”), AeroCision, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (the “US AeroCision Borrower”), AeroCision Parent, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (“US Holdings” and the “Initial US Holdco Borrower”) and, upon the consummation of the Closing Date Acquisition, Grantor, each lender from time to time party hereto (collectively, the “Lenders” and individually, a “Lender”), and the Second Lien Administrative Agent and (b) the Security Agreement referred to below.

(2) In connection with the Credit Agreement, the Grantor is a party to a Second Lien Security and Pledge Agreement, dated as of the date hereof (as amended, restated or otherwise modified from time to time, the “Security Agreement”), among the Grantor, the other grantors named therein and the Second Lien Administrative Agent, pursuant to which the Grantor has granted to the Second Lien Administrative Agent, for the benefit of the Secured Parties, a continuing security interest in, assignment of and lien on substantially all of its assets, whether now owned or existing or hereafter acquired or arising.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the mutual covenants contained herein and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Grantor hereby covenants and agrees with the Second Lien Administrative Agent and the other Secured Parties as follows:

### AGREEMENT:

Section 1. Defined Terms. Terms used herein without definition shall have the respective meanings ascribed thereto in the Security Agreement.

Section 2. Confirmation of Grant of Security Interest. As security for the prompt payment and performance of the Obligations (as defined in the Credit Agreement), the Grantor hereby confirms that, pursuant to the Security Agreement, it granted to the Second Lien Administrative Agent, for the benefit of the Secured Parties (as defined in the Credit Agreement), a continuing security interest in, a general lien upon and/or a right of set-off against (whether now owned or hereafter acquired by the Grantor and whether acquired in the United States or elsewhere in the world) all right, title and interest of the Grantor in and to the following, whether now existing or hereafter acquired and wherever located:

(i) all Trademarks registered with the United States Patent and Trademark Office (including, without limitation, those listed on Schedule A to this Agreement);

(ii) all applications for the registration of Trademarks filed with the United States Patent and Trademark Office (including, without limitation, those listed on Schedule A to this Agreement);

(iii) all trademarks, trade names and service marks registered with any office, agency or other Governmental Authority of any State, the District of Columbia or any possession or territory of the United States;

(iv) all trademarks, trade names and service marks registered with any office, agency or other Governmental Authority of any other country or any province, department or other governmental subdivision thereof;

(v) all registrations and recordings with respect to any of the foregoing;

(vi) all reissues, extensions and renewals of any of the foregoing;

(vii) all corporate names, business names, trade styles, logos, other source or business identifiers; all information, customer lists, identification of supplier, data, plans, blueprints, specifications, designs, drawings, recorded knowledge, surveys, engineering reports, test reports, manuals, materials standards, processing standards, performance standards, catalogs, computer and automatic machinery software and programs, and the like pertaining to operations by the Grantor in, on or about any of its plants or warehouses; all field repair data, sales data and other information relating to sales or service of products now or hereafter manufactured on or about any of its plants; and all accounting information pertaining to operations in, on or about any of its plants and all media in which or on which all of the information or knowledge or data or records relating to its plants and warehouses may be recorded or stored and all computer programs used for the compilation or printout of such information, knowledge, records or data, and the Second Lien Administrative Agent shall keep all such information, knowledge, records or data strictly confidential in accordance with the Credit Agreement;

(viii) all licenses and other agreements relating in whole or in part to any of the foregoing, including all rights to payments in respect thereof;

(ix) all rights to sue for past, present or future infringements of any of the foregoing;

(x) all good will related to any of the foregoing;

(xi) to the extent not included above, all general intangibles (as such term is defined in the UCC) of the Grantor related to the foregoing; and

(xii) all proceeds of any and all of the foregoing.

Section 3. Reference to Separate Security Agreement. This Agreement has been entered into by the Grantor and the Second Lien Administrative Agent primarily for recording purposes as contemplated by the Security Agreement. In the event of any inconsistency between any of the terms or provisions hereof and the terms and provisions of the Security Agreement, the terms and provisions of the Security Agreement shall govern.

Section 4. Governing Law; Counterparts. This Agreement shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the law of the State of New York. This Agreement may be executed in counterparts (and by different parties hereto in different counterparts), each of which shall constitute an original, but all of which when taken together shall constitute a single contract. Delivery of an executed counterpart of a signature page of this Agreement by facsimile or other electronic imaging (including in .pdf format) means shall be effective as delivery of a manually executed counterpart of this Agreement.


