TRADEMARK SECURITY AGREEMENT

This TRADEMARK SECURITY AGREEMENT (as amended, amended and restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, this "Trademark Security Agreement") dated June 5, 2020 is made by **WRIGHT MANUFACTURING, INC.**, a Maryland corporation ("Debtor"), in favor of **M&T BANK** ("Secured Party").

Reference is made to the Credit Agreement dated June 5, 2020 (as amended, restated, amended and restated, supplemented and/or otherwise modified from time to time, "Credit Agreement"), by and between the Debtor and Secured Party. Secured Party has agreed to extend credit to the Debtor and others subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Credit Agreement.

WHEREAS, as a condition precedent to Secured Party's extension of such credit, Debtor and others have executed and delivered to Secured Party the General Security Agreement dated June 5, 2020, made by the Debtor in favor of Secured Party (as amended, amended and restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, "Security Agreement").

WHEREAS, under the terms of the Security Agreement, the Debtor has granted to Secured Party a security interest in, among other property, certain intellectual property of the Debtor, and has agreed as a condition thereof to execute this Trademark Security Agreement for recording with the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Debtor agrees as follows:

SECTION 1. Terms. Capitalized terms used herein and not otherwise defined herein shall have the meaning ascribed to the in the Credit Agreement and Security Agreement, as applicable.

SECTION 2. Grant of Security. As security for the payment or performance, as the case may be, in full of the Obligations (as defined in the Security Agreement), Debtor hereby grants to Secured Party, its successors and assigns, a security interest in, all of Debtor's right, title and interest in, to and under all of the following Collateral (as defined in the Security Agreement) of Debtor (collectively, "Trademark Collateral"): (a) all trademarks, service marks, trade names, corporate names, company names, business names, fictitious business names, trade styles, trade dress, logos, internet domain names or other source or business identifiers or designs of like nature, the goodwill of the business symbolized thereby or associated therewith, all registrations thereof, and all registration applications filed in connection therewith, including registrations and registration applications in the United States Patent and Trademark Office or any similar offices in any State of the United States or any other country or any political subdivision thereof, including, without limitation, those listed on Schedule A attached hereto; (b) all rights and privileges arising under applicable law with respect to Debtor's use of any trademarks; (c) all extensions and renewals thereof; (d) all income, fees, royalties, damages and payments now and hereafter due and/or payable with respect to any of the foregoing, including damages, claims and payments for past, present or future infringements thereof; (e) all rights corresponding thereto throughout the world; (f) all rights to sue for past, present and future infringements or dilutions thereof; and (g) to the extent not otherwise included, all proceeds and products of any and all of the foregoing and all collateral security and guarantees given by any person with respect to any of the foregoing; provided that, in no event shall any security interest be granted in any "intent-to-use" application for registration of a Trademark filed pursuant to Section 1(b) of the Lanham Act, 15 U.S.C. § 1051, prior to the filing and acceptance by the United States Patent and Trademark Office of a "Statement of Use" pursuant to Section 1(d) of the Lanham Act or an "Amendment to Allege Use" pursuant to Section 1(c) of the Lanham Act with respect thereto, to the extent that, and during the period, if any, in which, the grant of a security interest therein would impair the validity or enforceability of any registration that issues from such intent-to-use application under applicable federal law (it being understood that after such period such intent-to-use application shall be automatically subject to the security interest granted herein).

SECTION 3. Security for Obligations. The grant of a security interest in the Trademarks by Debtor under this Trademark Security Agreement is made to secure the payment or performance, as the case may be, in full of the Obligations.

SECTION 4. Recordation. Debtor authorizes and requests that the Commissioner for Trademarks record this Trademark Security Agreement.

SECTION 5. Execution in Counterparts. This Trademark Security Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original but all of which when taken together shall constitute one and the same instrument. Delivery by telecopier or by electronic .pdf copy of an executed counterpart of a signature page to this Trademark Security Agreement shall be effective as delivery of an original executed counterpart of this Trademark Security Agreement.

SECTION 6. Security Agreement. This Trademark Security Agreement has been entered into in conjunction with the provisions of the Security Agreement. Debtor does hereby acknowledge and confirm that the grant of the security interest hereunder to, and the rights and remedies of, Secured Party with respect to the Collateral are more fully set forth in the Security Agreement, the terms and provisions of which are incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth herein. In the event that any provision of this Trademark Security Agreement is deemed to conflict with the Security Agreement, the provisions of the Security Agreement shall control.

SECTION 7. Governing Law. THIS TRADEMARK SECURITY AGREEMENT SHALL BE GOVERNED BY, AND CONSTRUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH, THE LAW OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND.

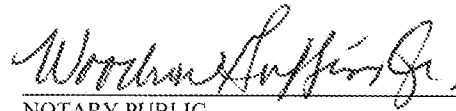
