**DECLARATION OF ANGUS NI
IN SUPPORT CORRECTIVE
ASSIGNMENT TO ORIGINAL,
TRUE OWNER**

I, Angus Ni, am over the age of 18 and have personal knowledge of the matters that I am declaring to here. I declare that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, the information herein is true and complete. I understand this statement is made for use as evidence before a government agency and in an official proceeding, and is subject to penalty of perjury.

1. I am an attorney licensed to practice in the state of New York and Washington. I filed the recordation of assignment dated November 26, 2020 of the above-captioned trademark.

2. On November 11, 2020, we were engaged to assign the above-captioned trademark. The client came to our offices in person and we had no reason to doubt his identity. We accepted the engagement and provided the assignment deed to the client on November 13, 2020 for signature confirmation, and the client sent the signed document back to us on the same day. We then proceeded to record the assignment.

3. On or about December 11, 2020, we were contacted by persons purporting to be the true owner of certain trademarks that we were engaged to assign, who claimed that his mark had been assigned without his consent.

4. The person did not provide his identity or any information showing his ownership of the marks.

5. On December 29, 2020, we received an e-mail from the USPTO informing us that one Mr. Haiqing Tang had e-mailed on December 11, 2020 to report unauthorized assignments of two separate trademarks that belonged to Mr. Tang.

6. After receiving the above communications, we contacted the client who engaged us to conduct the assignments of Mr. Tang's trademarks and asked him to provide identifying information of the assignor the above-captioned trademark, as well as proof that he had received authorization to request the assignment from the original owner and was the true trademark owner.

7. The client did not provide such evidence and ceased responding to follow-up communications.

8. Accordingly, we believe that we were fraudulently induced to undertake certain assignments by this client.

9. We therefore submit this corrective assignment to reverse the fraudulently induced assignment and re-record the original owner as the trademark's true, correct owner.

10. In addition to the two unauthorized assignments of Mr. Tang's trademarks, there are nine (9) other trademarks we were requested to assign by the same client, for a total of 11 trademarks that appear to have been wrongly re-assigned.

11. We will file corrective assignments for each of these trademarks.
