MEMBERSHIP INTEREST PURCHASE AGREEMENT

This **MEMBERSHIP INTEREST PURCHASE AGREEMENT** (this "Agreement") is entered into as of May 11, 2018, by and among Maroon Group, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (the "Buyer"), J. Tech Sales, L.L.C., a Florida limited liability company (the "Company"), Jeffrey Tannenbaum ("JT"), Barry Tannenbaum ("BT"), the Jeffrey Tannenbaum 2014 Irrevocable Trust (the "JT Trust") and the Susan Tannenbaum 2014 Irrevocable Trust (the "ST Trust", each of JT, BT, the JT Trust and the ST Trust, a "Seller" and collectively, the "Sellers"), and Jeffrey Tannenbaum, in his capacity as representative of the Sellers (in such capacity, the "Seller Representative"). Capitalized terms used but not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to them in Section 10.01 of this Agreement. The Buyer, the Sellers, the Company and the Seller Representative may be referred to herein each as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties".

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Sellers own, collectively, all of the issued and outstanding limited liability company membership interests of the Company (the "Membership Interests");

WHEREAS, each Seller owns the Membership Interests set forth next to such Seller's name on Exhibit A (the "Owned Membership Interests");

WHEREAS, concurrently with the execution and delivery of this Agreement, and as a condition and inducement to the Buyer's willingness to enter into this Agreement, each Rollover Seller has executed and delivered to the Buyer a contribution agreement, dated as of the date hereof, by and among each Rollover Seller and the Parent (collectively, the "Rollover Commitments"), pursuant to which each Rollover Seller has agreed that such Rollover Seller will, effective as of immediately prior to the Closing, contribute to the Parent, subject to the terms and conditions therein, such Rollover Seller's Rollover Interests in exchange for newly issued limited liability company interests in the Parent as described therein (the "Parent Interests");

WHEREAS, each Seller desires to sell to the Buyer, and the Buyer desires to purchase from such Seller, all of the Owned Membership Interests of such Seller other than such Seller's Rollover Interests (if any) (such Owned Membership Interests of all of the Sellers other than the Rollover Interests (if any), the "Transferred Interests");

WHEREAS, each Seller's pro rata portion (the "Pro Rata Portion") of the aggregate Transferred Interests is set forth next to such Seller's name on Exhibit B; and

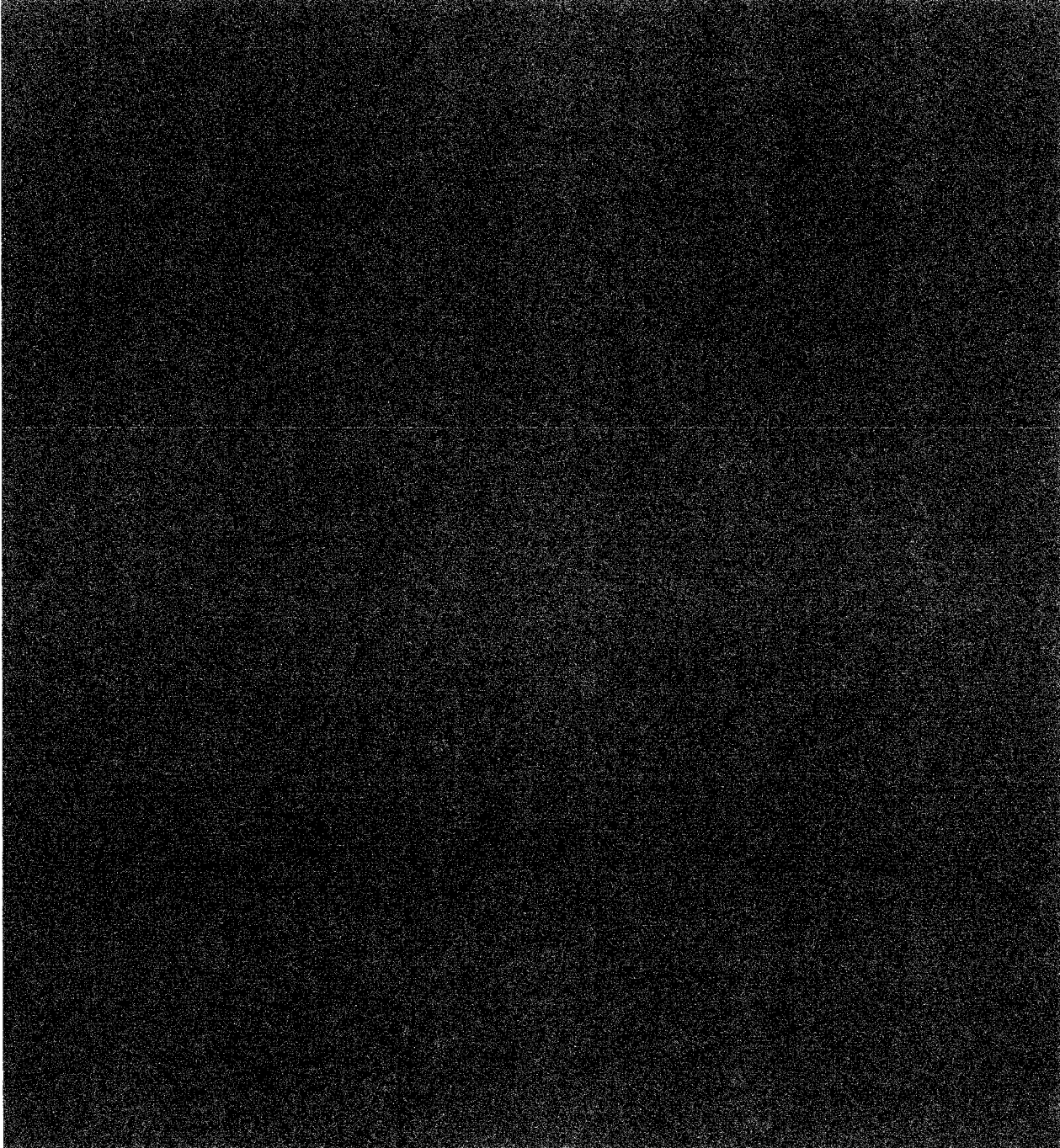
WHEREAS, concurrently with the execution and delivery of this Agreement, each of the Employment Parties is entering into and delivering to the Buyer an employment agreement with the Buyer, each of which is attached hereto as Exhibit C (together, the "Management Employment Agreements").

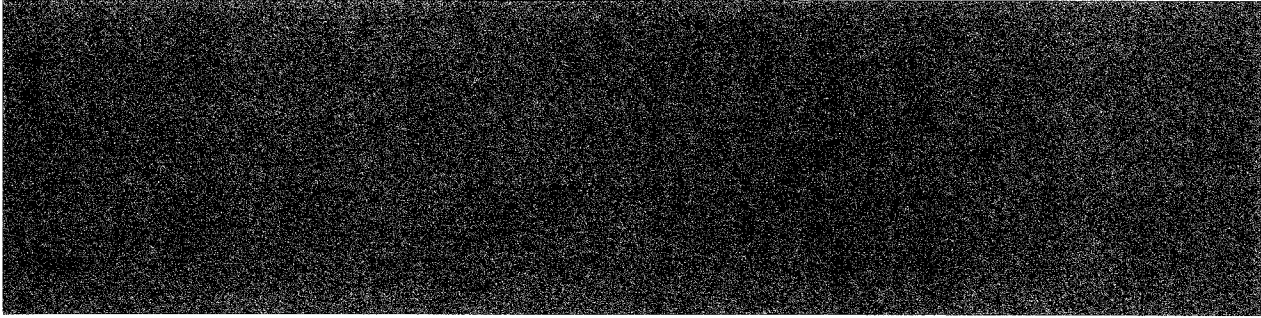

ARTICLE I

THE TRANSACTION

1.01 The Transferred Interest Purchase. Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, each Seller hereby sells, assigns, transfers and conveys to the Buyer at the Closing, free and clear of all Liens and Restrictions, and the Buyer hereby purchases and acquires from such Seller at the Closing, such Seller's Transferred Interests.

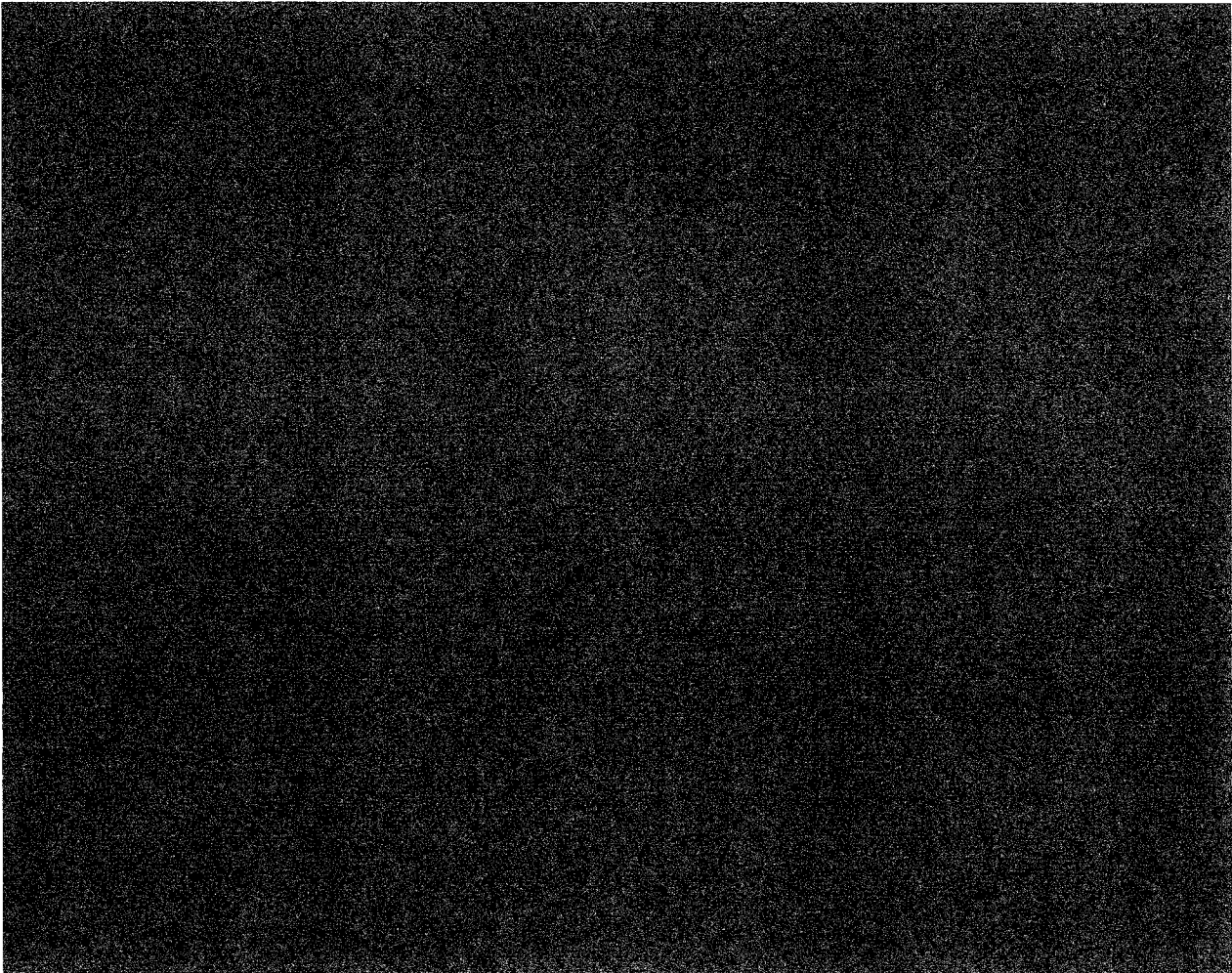
