TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

This partial Trademark Assignment is made this 1st day of August, 2023 (the “Effective Date”) by and between The Hymed Group Corporation, a Delaware corporation having a mailing address of 1817 Apple Tree Lane, Bethlehem, Pennsylvania 18015 (the “Assignor”) and Sanara MedTech Applied Technologies, LLC, a Texas limited liability company having a business address at 1200 Summit Avenue, Fort Worth, Texas 76102 (the “Assignee”).

Pursuant to an Asset Purchase Agreement executed by and between Assignor and Assignee on August 1, 2023, Assignee purchased from Assignor the assets of Assignor’s on-going and existing collagen human wound care business, including the right, title, and interest in and to the following trademarks and trademark applications filed with the United States Patent and Trademark Office (collectively, the “Marks”) as they pertain to goods related to the purchased collagen human wound care business, together with the goodwill symbolized thereby:

This Trademark Assignment is being executed to memorialize in writing the partial assignment of the Marks to Assignee only as they pertain to goods related to the purchased collagen human wound care business. Assignor retains all right, title and interest in and to the Marks for all uses in its on-going and existing business other than in connection with collagen human wound care, including all other human uses.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Assignor hereby sells, transfers, conveys and assigns in part to Assignee, its successors and assigns, the right, title and interest in and to the Marks only to the extent the Marks pertain to Assignee’s purchase of Assignor’s on-going and existing collagen human wound care business, together with the goodwill symbolized by said Marks as they relate to said collagen human wound care business, and with the right to recover damages and profits and all other remedies for all past and future infringements thereof related to use of the Marks in connection with said collagen human wound care business. All right, title, and interest in and to the Marks as they relate to Assignor’s on-going and existing business other than said collagen human wound care business sold to Assignee, including all other human uses, together with the separate and distinct goodwill associated therewith, is expressly retained by Assignor.

A request to divide each of U.S. Trademark Application Nos. 97/446,990 and 97/604,624 into separate applications owned by the Assignor and Assignee is being concurrently filed with

the Commissioner for Trademarks to ensure USPTO records accurately reflect current ownership.

The description of goods for U.S. Trademark Application Nos. 97/446,990 and 97/604,624 shall be amended in the request to divide to reflect the partial assignment of the Marks, as follows:

Assignor:

International Class 03: *Collagen for use in the manufacture of cosmetics, nutritional supplements, and pharmaceutical preparations for other than human use; Collagen for use as a chemical carrier for cosmetic purposes; Collagen preparations for cosmetic purposes.*

International Class 05: *Collagen for other than human wound care medical purposes; Pharmaceutical preparations, namely, collagen for non-human wound and tissue treatment and care, dental purposes, and the treatment of arthritis; Pharmaceutical preparations and substances for the treatment of damaged skin and tissue; Dietary and nutritional supplements containing collagen; Collagen for use as a dietary or nutritional supplement.*


